Important Notes

- This is a fun show and is not an ARBA-sanctioned show. ARBA legs and sweepstakes points are not awarded.
- All 53 currently recognized ARBA rabbit breeds are eligible, using the applicable showroom classes in the current Standard of Perfection.
- Open and Youth entries will be judged in separate divisions.
- Exhibitors are responsible for entering each rabbit in the correct breed, variety, sex and age class.

Breed showroom classes will follow the current ARBA Standard of Perfection. Use the class structure applicable to the rabbit's breed.

Entry Information Needed

- Ear number / permanent identification
- Breed
- Variety
- Sex: Buck or Doe
- Class/Age: Senior, Intermediate (6-Class breeds where applicable), or Junior
- Division: Open or Youth

Note: Age and weight requirements vary by breed. The current ARBA Standard of Perfection controls when determining the proper showroom class.

Awards

Awards are offered in both Open and Youth divisions as applicable.

Award	Recognition
Best in Show (BIS)	Selected from eligible Best of Breed winners.
Reserve in Show (RIS)	Second overall selection following Best in Show.
Honorable Mention	Additional overall recognition selected by the show judge.
Best of Breed (BOB)	Top rabbit of an eligible breed.
Best Opposite Sex of Breed (BOSB)	Top rabbit of the opposite sex from the Best of Breed winner.
Best of Variety (BOV)	Awarded where the breed is shown by recognized varieties.
Best Opposite Sex of Variety (BOSV)	Awarded where applicable within a recognized variety.

Fun Show Notice: These awards are Taylor County Swap fun-show awards and do not represent ARBA legs or ARBA sweepstakes points.

Show Rules

- 1.** This is a fun show and is not an ARBA-sanctioned show. No ARBA legs or sweepstakes points will be awarded.
- 2.** Rabbits will be judged according to the current ARBA Standard of Perfection. Breed, variety, age, sex, weight, faults and disqualifications will be considered according to the applicable breed standard.
- 3.** Open and Youth will be shown as separate divisions. Youth exhibitors are 18 years of age and younger.
- 4.** 4-Class and 6-Class breeds will use the applicable ARBA showroom class structure.
- 5.** Each exhibitor is responsible for entering rabbits in the correct breed, variety, sex and age class.
- 6.** Rabbits must have permanent, legible identification in the left ear for show identification.
- 7.** Any rabbit showing signs of disease, illness or an unsightly condition may be removed from the show area by show management.
- 8.** Rabbits are to be shown in their natural condition. Artificial alteration intended to change appearance for judging is not permitted.
- 9.** The judge's decision on placements, faults and disqualifications is final for this fun show.
- 10.** Exhibitors are responsible for getting their rabbits to the judging table when their breed or class is called.
- 11.** Pre-entry is \$2.00 per rabbit and must be received by October 17, 2026. Day-of-show entry is \$4.00 per rabbit.
- 12.** All rabbits must be checked in by 8:30 AM. Judging begins at 9:00 AM.
- 13.** Taylor County Swap and show personnel are not responsible for loss, theft, injury, illness or death of animals or personal property associated with participation in the event.
- 14.** Show management reserves the right to make reasonable adjustments necessary for the orderly operation of the fun show.
